PMI-SVC Board of Directors Elections

The PMI-SVC Board of Directors (BOD) Election cycle is about to begin!

It is led by the PMI-SVC Board of Directors Election Committee (Election Committee) who is charged with completing the process of electing new board members to serve on the board, in a fair and impartial manner.

Elections Cycle

PMI-SVC members had the opportunity to vote for candidates in the positions for the 2027-2028 term (term start: January 1, 2027, to term end: December 31, 2028).

The open positions are:

- Vice President of Career Development
- Vice President of Events
- Vice President of Marketing
- Vice President of Operations

Nominations

The Election Committee accepted nominations for those who are eligible to run. Whether nominated by someone or self-nominated, proof of good standing membership with PMI Global must be provided to the Election Committee on or before the specified date.

Candidates have been vetted and their statements are posted on the Chapter website and will be on the PMI Global for the ballot.

'Meet and Greet the Candidates' Forum

This 'question-and-answer' forum allows Chapter membership to meet the candidates before the polls open.

The Forum is on Wednesday, July 15, 2026, at the Frequency Lounge, 3249 Quality Drive, Rancho Cordova. Registration will be required.

Voting process

The voting process will take place electronically from July 27 to August 10, 2026 (11:59 PM PST). Chapter members in good standing will receive a link to cast your vote. Note: Check your Spam/Junk folder.

The Election Committee partners with PMI Global for the voting process. It is important that your email is update with PMI Global thirty (30) days before polls open.

Voting requires you to be logged into the PMI-SVC website to validate your membership status. Use your PMI Global login credentials to validate.

The link is designed for one time use and you may only vote once. If you submit an electronic ballot more than once, your first submission will be the vote that is counted.
